In the past ten years, the idea of semantic satiation has intrigued many people and has entered the popular discussions in the form of music videos, chat room discussions, dance, and art. Because of this continued interest in semantic satiation on the part of academic researchers and the popular culture, the author has decided to publish the original text of his doctoral dissertation.
