

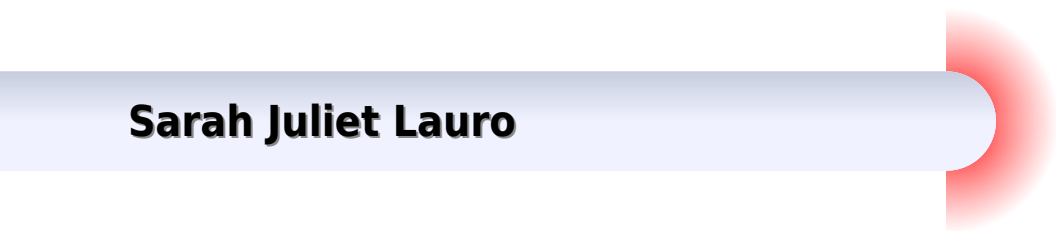

Maldoror & the Complete Works of the Comte de Lautreamont comte de Lautréamont, 1994 Andre Breton wrote that MALDOROR is the expression of a revelation so complete it seems to exceed human potential First published in 1869 MALDOROR is the work of a mysterious genius about whom little is known aside from his birth in Uruguay 1846 and his early death in Paris 1870 His writings published under the pseudonym Comte de Lautreamont bewildered his contemporaries but have since taken their place alongside other French classics of transgression such as Sade Baudelaire Rimbaud A unique translation Encyclopedia of Literary Translation Into English: A-L O. Debord describes and critiques the way we live. The power in these ideas lies in their ability to question, identify, and name the common assumptions of the present. From its publication just before and ultimately influencing the May 1968 revolt in Paris and Occupy Wall Street, this book continues to transform a wide range of progressive philosophical

and political movements most notably anti capitalism postmodernism marxism and anarchism This new translation brings a concrete edge to the text elaborating upon the original and adding annotations Bringing fifty years of prominent radical thinking back to the text from Baudrillard to Odell to Zuboff it s clear that Debords book is more relevant in the era of social media the attention economy and the emergence of Surveillance Capitalism than ever before **John Ashbery and You** John Emil Vincent,2007 John Ashbery and You approaches Ashbery s critically neglected recent poetry with an ear to his use of the supremely elastic pronoun you and an eye toward his construction of his books as books Together these devices produce effects new to Ashbery s oeuvre and offer readers new ways in to his work John Ashbery and You argues that starting with April Galleons 1987 and reaching an apex in Your Name Here 2000 the poet has been paying increasingly keen and affectionate attention to his readers Vincent tracks these techniques but above all offers his readers tools to reapproach a dauntingly difficult body of work Some critics have suggested that Ashbery is producing books too quickly for criticism to keep up or that the later books represent as Vincent summarizes it a kind of logorrhea and therefore don t really register as separate events as much as episodic eruptions of one big volcano which is the Later Ashbery Vincent contends that critics are not keeping up with Ashbery not so much because it is all of a piece but rather because his work varies so much from volume to volume Each of the volumes from the latter part of Ashbery s career represents an individual and different poetic project depending precisely on the unit of the book to produce its effects By showing us that the entry point to Ashbery is not any given individual poem within a volume but the entire volume Vincent gives us a new and productive approach to reading the recent work of one of our most challenging poets **Architecture in Abjection** Zuzana Kovar,2017-11-30 This book marks a turning point in architectural theory by using philosophy to examine the field anew Breaking from the traditional dualism within architecture which presents the body as subject and space as object it examines how such rigid boundaries can be softened Zuzana Kovar thus engages with complementary and complex ideas from architecture philosophy feminist theory and other subjects demonstrating how both bodies and bodily functions relate deeply to architecture Extending philosopher Julia Kristeva s notion of abjection the confrontation of one s own corporeality as something is excreted Kovar finds parallels in the concept of the scaffold Much like living bodies and their products can impact on the buildings that house them old skin cells create dust menstrual blood stains our breath heats and cools surfaces scaffolding is similarly ephemeral and yet not entirely separable from the architecture it supports Kovar shifts the conversation about abjection towards a more nuanced idea of architecture where living organisms building matter space decay and waste are all considered as part of a continual process drawing on the key informing works of thinkers like Gilles Deleuze and Felix Guattari to do this Including a number of experimental projects conducted in the spaces inhabited by the author herself to illuminate the theory at its core the book forms a distinguished and pioneering study designed for practitioners and scholars of architecture philosophy and visual culture alike *Inner Experience* Georges Bataille (1897-1962),2014-07-24 Outlines a mystical theology and experience of
