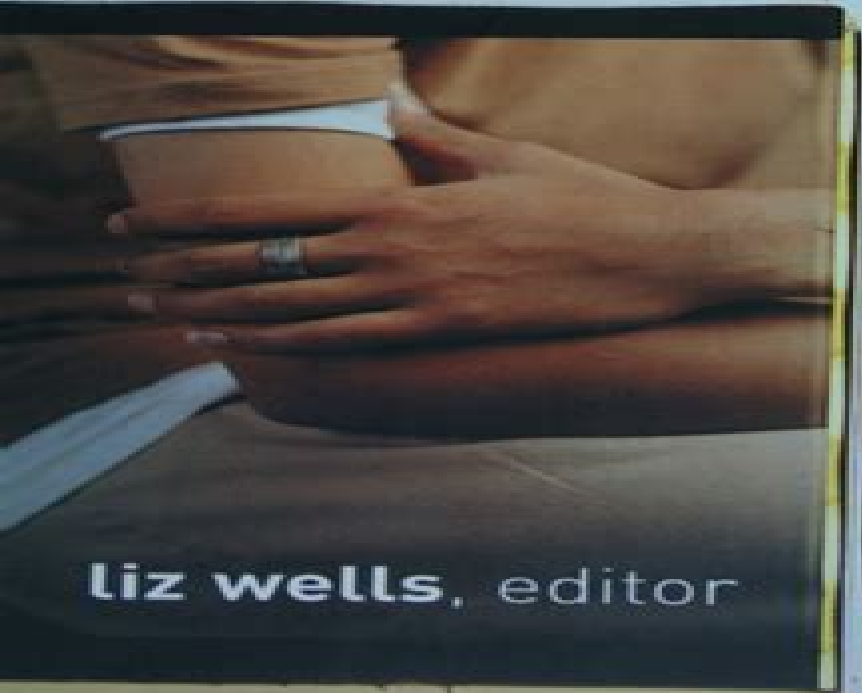

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web conclusion this lab evaluated an acid base reaction with the volumetric analysis of a standard solution being naoh reaction with a 2nd substance $\text{H}_2\text{C}_2\text{O}_4 + 2\text{NaOH} \rightarrow \text{Na}_2\text{C}_2\text{O}_4 + 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$ to differentiate an acid from a base in a solution a pH scale is used the pH scale ranges from 0 to 14 a pH of 7 is neutral in an acid base reaction

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web this point of titration is referred to as the equivalence point considering the 1 1 stoichiometry of this acid base reaction $\text{NaOH} + \text{C}_6\text{H}_4\text{COOH} \rightarrow \text{C}_6\text{H}_4\text{COONa} + \text{H}_2\text{O}$ the point of equivalence is the point of titration when the number of moles of naoh added is equal to the number of moles of khp in the

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
