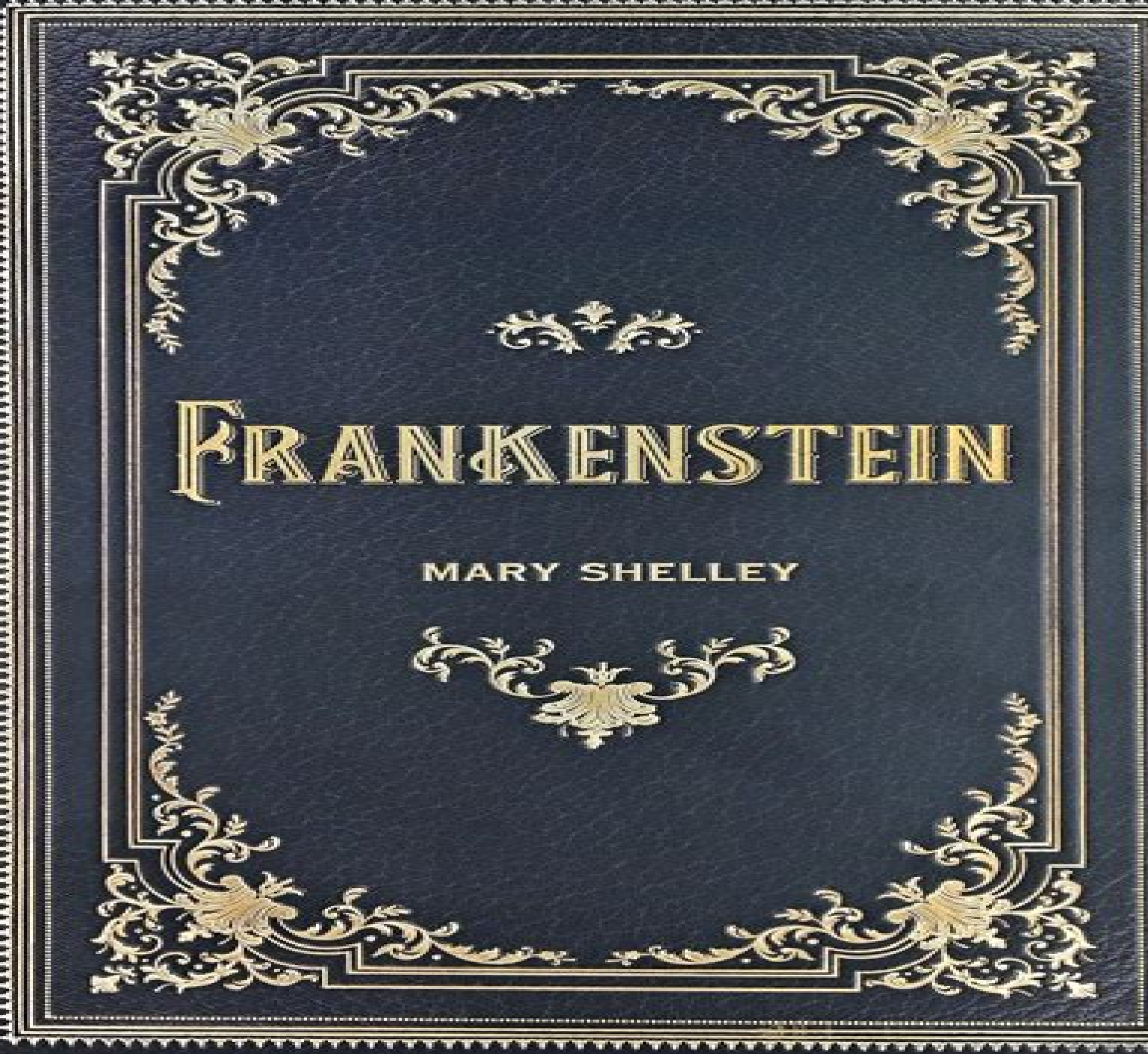

We can also see for the first time the extent of Percy Shelley's contribution: some 5,000 words out of 72,000 and his stylistic and thematic changes. Interesting too are Percy's suggestions which humanize the monster thus shaping many of the major themes of the novel as we read it today.
