

The aim, though not entirely novel, is commendable, and many topics are well treated. Nevertheless I cannot recommend this book. My overall impression is that the manuscript was too hurriedly produced, and would have been much improved by the ruthlessly critical comments of a colleague not too closely connected with the course on which it was based. There is far too much evidence of a lack of that attention to matters of detail which a purchaser has the right to expect in what is, essentially, an introduction to the standard theory of measure and integration.

Foundations of optimum experimental design, by Andrej Pázman. Pp 228. £30.50. 1986. ISBN 90-277-1865-2 (Reidel)

This book is in a series, 'Mathematics and its applications (East European Series)', and has a Czech author. The translation into English is generally good. It is largely an exploration of the general regression model with uncorrelated observations, considering a variety of optimality criteria. Although it is intended to be a 'starting point for further research' and also a 'textbook for students of statistics' (Preface to the English edition), it is by no means elementary, using amongst other delights linear functionals, Hilbert spaces, uniform ordering of designs, convex hulls.

Only the introductory chapter is likely to interest any but the specialist. It contains an interesting example indicating that good weighing strategies (with a balance) may be unexpected ones. Even this chapter though in parts has to rely heavily on references back from later chapters. The title of Chapter II (of seven) is 'The regression model and methods of estimation', but soon plunges into metric spaces and linear spaces of functions defined on such, etc. Generally in the book there is much advanced linear algebra and analysis. In short—a book only for those who have already reached a high level of sophistication mathematically.

Morton Davis is a member of the Department of Mathematics of City College, New York. By analysing decisions to be made (by his compatriots) in finance, industry, management and games, he argues that intuition and common sense are unreliable aids. He poses a variety of problems and indicates appropriate techniques for their solution; he finds mathematical diagrams, algebra, differential calculus and probability particularly helpful and suggests books for further reading.

The reader is expected to have a knowledge of basic (American) high school mathematics and to be ambitious for wealth and success. The able A-level student may not share such ambitions but should find this slim volume an enjoyable addition to his reading list and the problems challenging.

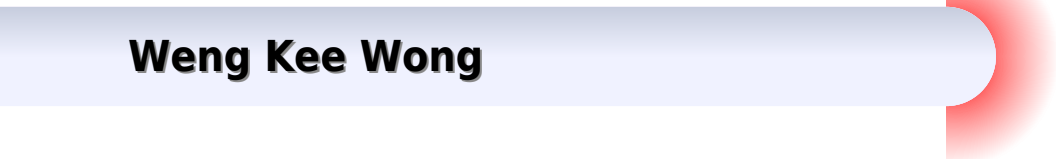
This book would make a splendid text book for a General Studies course on decision making.
