



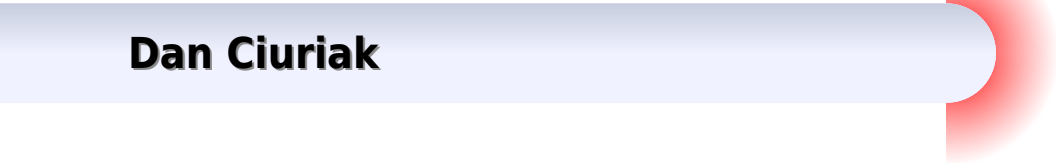

Calomiris, Stephen Haber, 2015-08-04 Why stable banking systems are so rare Why are banking systems unstable in so many countries but not in others The United States has had twelve systemic banking crises since 1840 while Canada has had none The banking systems of Mexico and Brazil have not only been crisis prone but have provided miniscule amounts of credit to business enterprises and households Analyzing the political and banking history of the United Kingdom the United States Canada Mexico and Brazil through several centuries *Fragile by Design* demonstrates that chronic banking crises and scarce credit are not accidents Calomiris and Haber combine political history and economics to examine how coalitions of politicians bankers and other interest groups form why they endure and how they generate policies that determine who gets to be a banker who has access to credit and who pays for bank bailouts and rescues *Fragile by Design* is a revealing exploration of the ways that politics inevitably intrudes into bank regulation **Fragile by Design**

Calomiris, Book Review Dan Ciuriak, 2016 *Fragile by Design* suggests a unifying explanation for systematic differences across countries in the domestic supply of credit and the susceptibility of banking systems to failure The centrepiece is a theory of The Game of Bank Bargains the Game which is played between bankers governments and those with political power from aristocratic elites and oligarchs to unions and farmers coalitions The implicit bargains they strike determine whether credit is abundant or restricted and whether the banking system is stable or crisis prone The strength of the book lies in its assembly of the vast history of the chartered bank as an institution and integration of this history into the history of the various countries studied The book's ultimate message is sobering countries do not choose their banking systems but rather they get a banking system consistent with the institutions that govern the distribution of political power within their societies Reform is possible but the challenges go well beyond getting the technical regulation of banks right The main limitations of the theory reflect its focus on national determinants in an age of globalization and the non observable nature of the bargains that determine national outcomes This limits the predictive power of the model
