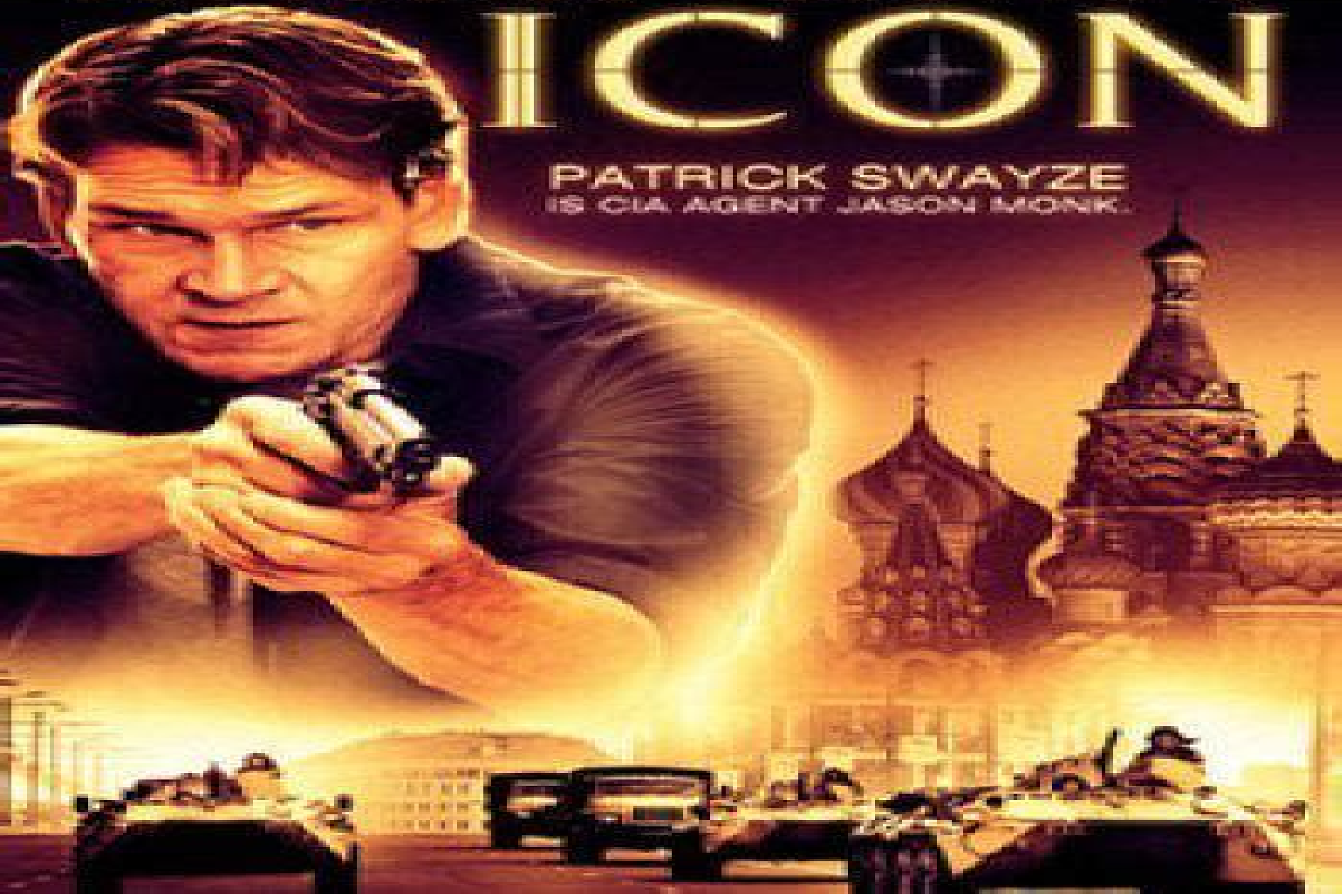

investigation and remains in close contact with Litvinenko's widow details the events surrounding Litvinenko's murder Volodarsky updates the story referring to the findings of the official British inquiry on the release of which Prime Minister David Cameron condemned Putin for presiding over state sponsored murder The author proves that the Litvinenko's poisoning is just one of many Some of these assassinations or attempted assassinations are already known others are revealed by him for the first time
