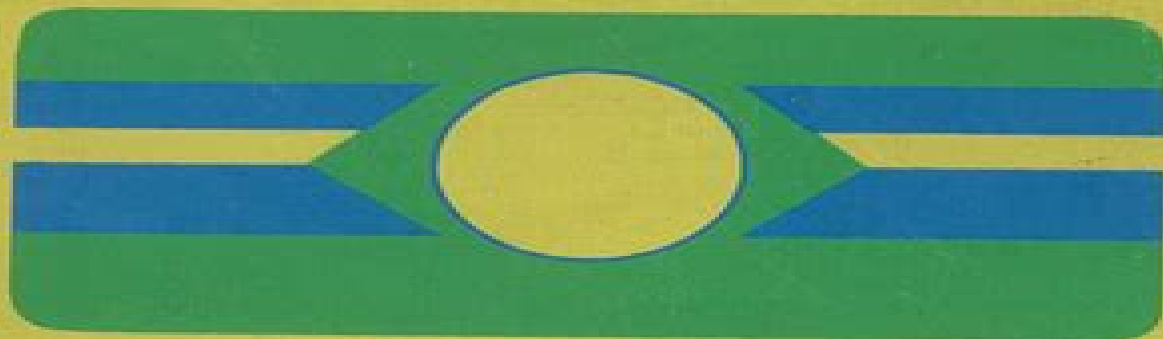

things to respond adaptively to environmental challenges Underlying these controversies was the unresolved problem of integrating physiology and other areas of functional biology with the emerging evolutionary synthesis of Mendelian genetics and Darwinian natural selection The physiological idea of homeostasis as the adaptive fit between the organism and its environment and the Darwinian idea of adaptation and fitness in terms of reproductive success might seem to be complementary in an unproblematic way but historically they have had an uneasy relationship
