The Moral Philosophy of Bernard Williams Chris Herrera, Alexandra Perry, 2014-08-11 Bernard Williams 1929 2003 is one of the most influential philosophers of the past 100 years with work ranging from meta ethics to philosophy of mind to reflections on pop culture Williams wrote with a deep sensitivity to the limitations in our knowledge and an optimistic outlook on the prospects that we have nonetheless for social and moral progress If Williams was right we still have much to learn from the Classical world and much of the responsibility that intellectuals have relates to the need to interpret and apply that knowledge But Williams was not stuck in the past and he did not advocate a rejection of science or modernity Instead Williams argued that there is often more knowledge around us than we realize and more opportunity than we realize for refinements in our basic ideas about persons ethics and politics This anthology showcases some of the best and most recent work from scholars working through some of the problems that Williams identified As Williams might have expected there is a great deal of disagreement on selected points and even on the particular approach used But in their commitment to a reflective and always somewhat skeptical outlook the authors here continue a tradition that Williams felt was vital

The Ethics of Conceptualization Matthieu Queloz, 2025-01-31 Philosophy strives to give us a firmer hold on our concepts But what about their hold on us Why place ourselves under the sway of a concept and grant it the authority to shape our thought and conduct Another
