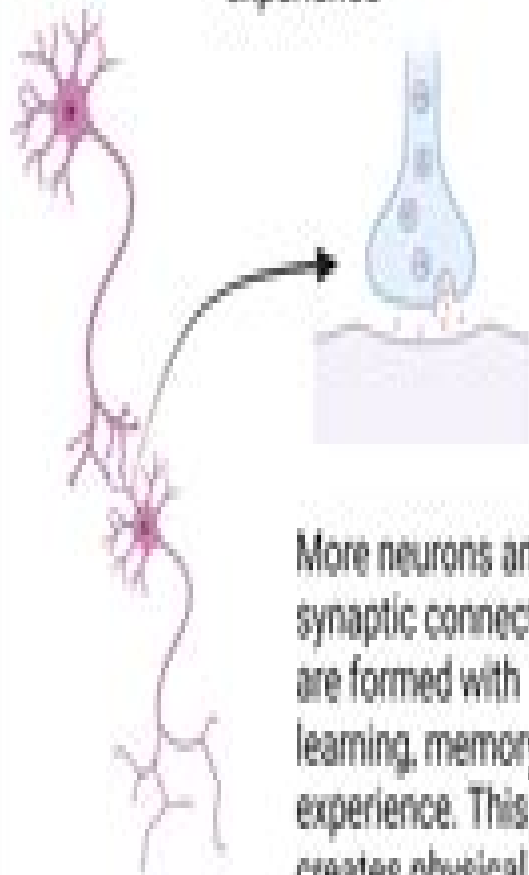


Structural Neuroplasticity

Functional Neuroplasticity

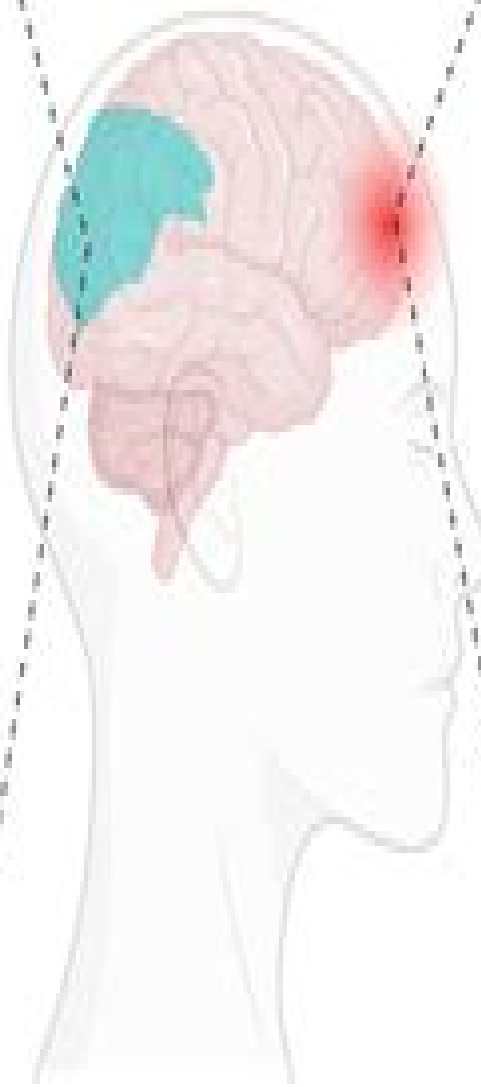
Synaptic remodeling following brain dysfunction or injury
