Bailt: You receive an email asking you to confirm a new email address was added to your account. The email then provides a link for you to click on if you did not authorize the change. The link directs you to a site that is secure but will then redirect you to a second site, which is unsecured. Both websites are take. Security Tip: When you log in to your PayPal account, be sure to open up a new Web browser window and type in the PayPal URL (https://www.paypal.com) yourself. This will help ensure that you are taken to a secure, genuine PayPal Web site.

Subject: Amazon - Congratulations! Amazon.com Gold Box Reward

Built: An email asks you to confirm/update/verify your account data at Amazon by visiting the embedded link. You'll notice that the site does not have a security lock displayed in your browser. This indicates the site is not secure, and its absence is a telltale sign that the site may be bogus.
