I. Phishing Scams

Subject: PayPal – Account Notification

Bait: You receive an email asking you to confirm a new email address was added to your account. The email then provides a link for you to click on if you did not authorize the change. The link directs you to a site that is secure but will then redirect you to a second site, which is unsecured. Both websites are fake. **Security Tip:** When you log in to your PayPal account, be sure to open up a new Web browser window and type in the PayPal URL (<https://www.paypal.com>) yourself. This will help ensure that you are taken to a secure, genuine PayPal Web site.

Subject: Amazon - Congratulations! Amazon.com Gold Box Reward

Bait: An email asks you to confirm/update/verify your account data at Amazon by visiting the embedded link. You'll notice that the site does not have a security lock displayed in your browser. This indicates the site is not secure, and its absence is a telltale sign that the site may be bogus.

Securing Human Rights? accounting of Israeli violations of Palestinian human rights Their consistent evasion of the substantive charges made by careful reporting and recourse by Israeli supporters to discrediting defamatory attacks on the persons of these Special Rapporteurs with charges of anti-Semitism the core of which is subtly shifted from its proper usage as hatred of Jews to justifiable criticism of the state of Israel While some might argue that the UN inability to enforce international law as futile or worse view the UN as merely a vehicle of power politics this book proves that international public opinion and international solidarity politics are influenced by persuasive expert findings as to international law Such well evidenced conclusions encourage transnational activism as is evident from increased worldwide support for the BDS Campaign and other nonviolent external pressures This brilliant and authoritative account of the manner in which Israel has administered the Occupied Palestinian Territory during the past 20 years should be regarded as the definitive assessment of that situation

Protecting Human Rights Todd Landman, 2005-10-04. Ours has been called a global age of rights, an era in which respect for human rights is considered the highest aspiration of the international democratic community. Since the United Nations 1948 Universal Declaration of Human Rights, a wide variety of protections, civil, political, economic, social and cultural, have been given legal validation as countries ratify treaties, participate in intergovernmental organizations and establish human rights tribunals and truth and reconciliation commissions. He argues that the influence human rights ideals have begun to have on states cannot be separated from the broader impact of socioeconomic changes that swept the globe in the late twentieth century. Landman concludes that international law alone will not suffice to fully protect human rights; it must be accompanied by democratic government, effective conflict resolution and just economic systems.
