ROCK,2018 *The 1930s HOUSE MANUAL* Ian Rock,2023-01-27 **Ideal homes, 1918-39** Deborah Sugg Ryan,2018-03-06 This book explores the aspirations and tastes of new suburban communities in interwar England for domestic architecture and design that was both modern and nostalgic in a period where homeownership became the norm It investigates the ways in which new suburban class and gender identities were forged through the architecture design and decoration of the home in choices such as ebony elephants placed on mantelpieces and modern Easiwork dressers in kitchens Ultimately it argues that a specifically suburban modernism emerged which looked backwards to the past whilst looking forward to the future Thus the inter war ideal home was both a retreat from the outside world and a site of change and experimentation The book also examines how the interwar home is lived in today It will appeal to academics and students in design social and cultural history as well as a wider readership curious about interwar homes

Life in a Kam Village in Southwest China, 1930-1949 Chaoquan Ou, 2007-10-31 Although this unique insider's account of minority life in China is clearly a book in itself, it is also the sequel to the much acclaimed *The Kam People of China* by Geary Ou and others, 2003. It describes the hitherto scarcely researched culture of people from Xiangye village in an untravelled corner of Guizhou province, Southwest China, in the 20 years leading up to Liberation in 1949. Xiangye is a Kam Dong nationality village, so the book highlights Kam culture of the 1930s and 1940s. Modernist Semis and Terraces in England Finn Jensen, 2012 Between the two World Wars there was an unprecedented need for new houses in Britain which resulted in a building boom While only a small percentage of this building took the form of Modernism there was still a significant number of semis and terraces built for the workers and middle class families in the 1920s and 1930s built in this style This book examines these modest Modernist houses within the broader context of the Modern Movement in Europe as well as the inter war building boom in suburban Britain Illustrated with line drawings and photographs of more than 30 examples from around the country and based on little known contemporary material such as catalogues advertisements radio broadcasts and letters it shows how these houses speak of a time of political social and artistic unrest and a world where the avant garde architects sought to capture the spirit of modern technology in their designs for the average home owner While the Modernist houses never became popular with the general public the fact that so many are still standing and now sought after by twenty first century families speak for their endurance and special appeal

Culinary Landmarks Elizabeth Driver, 2008-04-05 Culinary Landmarks is a definitive history and bibliography of Canadian cookbooks from the beginning when La cuisini re bourgeoise was published in Quebec City in 1825 to the mid twentieth
