The Old Testament in Eastern Orthodox Tradition Eugen J. Pentiuc, 2014-01-09 This study provides a general overview and a succinct analysis of the primary ways in which the Old Testament has been received interpreted and conveyed within Eastern Orthodox tradition filling a vacuum in scholarly literature on the history of biblical interpretation The book is divided into two parts Reception and Interpretation Under Reception issues such as unity and diversity of the Christian Bible text canon and Tradition are considered The second part Interpretation focuses on Eastern Orthodox modes of interpretation discursive and intuitive Among the discursive modes the patristic exegesis is chosen as a case study The intuitive modes representing the so called liturgical exegesis are subdivided into aural hymns psalmody lectionaries and visual portable icons frescoes mosaics A special

emphasis is placed on the hallmarks of Eastern Orthodox reception and interpretation of the Old Testament including the centrality of Scripture within Tradition a blend of flexibility and strictness at all levels of the faith community integrative function and holistic use of the sacred text a tensed unity of discursive and intuitive modes of interpretation and a dynamic synergy between formative and informative goals in the use of Scripture

Practices, Politics, and Performance Michael G. Cartwright, 2006-06-01 Drawing on the hermeneutical reflections of John Howard Yoder Stanley Hauerwas and Mikhail Bakhtin Cartwright challenges the way twentieth century American Protestants have engaged the problem of the use of scripture in Christian ethics and issues a summons for a new debate oriented by a communal approach to hermeneutics By analyzing particular ecclesial practices that stand within living traditions of Christianity the politics of scriptural interpretation can be identified along with the criteria for what a good performance of scripture should be This approach to the use of scripture in Christian ethics is displayed in historical discussions of two Christian practices through which scripture is read ecclesiologically the Eastern Orthodox liturgical celebration of the Eucharist and the Anabaptist practice of binding and loosing or the rule of Christ When American Protestants consider performances of scripture such as these alongside one another within more ecumenical contexts they begin to confront the ecclesiological problem with their attempts to use the Bible in Christian ethics the relative absence of constitutive ecclesial practices in American Protestant congregations that can provide moral orientation for their interpretations of Christian scripture

The Oxford Handbook of the Septuagint Alison G. Salvesen, Timothy Michael Law, 2021-01-26 The Septuagint is the term commonly used to refer to the corpus of early Greek versions of Hebrew Scriptures The collection is of immense importance in the history of both Judaism and Christianity The renderings of individual books attest to the religious interests of the substantial Jewish population of Egypt during the Hellenistic and Roman periods and to the development of the Greek language in its Koine phase The narrative ascribing the Septuagint's origins to the work of seventy translators in Alexandria attained legendary status among both Jews and Christians The Septuagint was the version of Scripture most familiar to the writers of the New Testament and became the authoritative Old Testament of the Greek and Latin Churches In the early centuries of Christianity it was itself translated into several other languages and it has had a continuing influence on the style and content of biblical translations The Oxford Handbook of the Septuagint features contributions from leading experts in the field considering the history and manuscript transmission of the version and the study of translation technique and textual criticism The collection provides surveys of previous and current research on individual books of the Septuagint corpus on alternative Jewish Greek versions the Christian daughter translations and reception in early Jewish and Christian writers The Handbook also includes several conversations with related fields of interest such as New Testament studies liturgy and art history

to him although he filled them in with altered contents This especially concerns the emphasis on asceticism the Cretan religious popular culture the language of Scripture various liturgical rituals as well as Byzantine hymnody and iconography
