The Threepenny Opera Bertolt Brecht, Kurt Weill, 2022-02-10 One of Bertolt Brecht s best loved and most performed plays The Threepenny Opera was first staged in 1928 at the Theater am Schiffbauerdamm Berlin now the home of the Berliner Ensemble Based on the eighteenth century The Beggar s Opera by John Gay the play is a satire on the bourgeois society of the Weimar Republic but set in a mock Victorian Soho With Kurt Weill s music which was one of the earliest and most successful attempts to introduce the jazz idiom into the theatre it became a popular hit throughout the western world This new edition is published here in John Willett and Ralph Manheim s classic translation with commentary and notes by Anja Hartl

Die Dreigroschenoper Kurt Weill, 1928 **Kurt Weill: The Threepenny Opera** Stephen Hinton, 1990-07-26 This is the first book on the best known of the Weill Brecht collaborations to explore the extent and significance of the composer s contribution Described as the weightiest possible lowbrow opera for highbrows and the most full blooded highbrow musical for lowbrows Hans Keller the enduringly popular Threepenny Opera has given rise not only to interpretations as numerous as they are diverse but also to new adaptations One such is Brecht s hitherto unpublished concert version which is included here in English translation Even the stage work generally known today departs significantly from what was performed at the premiere in 1928 After a detailed reconstruction of the work s genesis and continued revision over three decades the editor examines the spin offs in which the authors participated the instrumental suite the film the law suit the novel and the musical and textual revisions of songs In a brisk survey of the stage history the editor pays particular attention to pioneering productions in Germany and Britain Kim Kowalke provides an exhaustive account of the history of The Threepenny Opera in America Geoffrey Abbott addresses questions concerning authentic performance practice and David Drew analyzes large scale motivic relationships in the music Among the earlier writings on the work reprinted here those by Theodor W Adorno Ernst Bloch and Walter Benjamin appear for the first time in English translation A concluding chapter by the editor considers whether The Threepenny Opera s popularity rests as frequently maintained on a misunderstanding The book contains numerous illustrations a discography and music examples

Weill, Blitzstein, and Bernstein Rebecca Schmid,2023 The first study to explore the crucial influence of Kurt Weill on operas and musicals by Marc Blitzstein and Leonard Bernstein Theodor Adorno famously proclaimed that the model of Kurt Weill could not be repeated Yet Weill's stage works set an inescapable precedent for composers on both sides of the Atlantic Rebecca Schmid explores how Weill's formal innovations in particular laid the groundwork for operas and musicals by Marc Blitzstein and Leonard Bernstein although both composers resisted or downplayed his aesthetic contribution to American tradition Comparative analysis based on Harold Bloom's *Anxiety of Influence* and other modes of intertextuality reveals that the principles of Weill's opera reform would catalyze an indigenous movement in sophisticated socially engaged music theatre Weill Blitzstein and Bernstein A Study of Influence focuses on works that represent different phases of Weill's mission to renew the genre of opera evolving from *Die Dreigroschenoper* to the musical play *Lady in the Dark* and the Broadway Opera *Street Scene* Blitzstein and Bernstein in turn defied formal boundaries with *The Cradle Will Rock* *Regina Trouble in Tahiti* *Candide* and *West Side Story* part of a short lived movement in mid twentieth century America that coincided with a renaissance for Weill's German period works following the premiere of Blitzstein's translation *The Threepenny Opera* under Bernstein's baton The unpublished *A Prayer by Blecht* for which Bernstein rejoined Stephen Sondheim and Jerome Robbins his collaborators on *West Side Story* deepens the connection of Bernstein's aesthetic to Weill

Die Dreigroschenoper (The Threepenny Opera) Jeffrey Wienckowski,2011 The last full production I directed before coming to Graduate School was Bertolt Brecht's *Mother Courage and her Children* At the time I paid little attention to Brecht's theories about Epic Theatre and staged the play on my terms Little by little it overwhelmed me and slipped from my grasp It was my biggest artistic failure making me seriously question my abilities as an artist While my time at UCSD helped me regain my confidence and hone new artistic skills the thought of revisiting Brecht was a daunting one The thing I learned about tackling Brecht is that you cannot deal with him as just the playwright You must also acknowledge Brecht the Director and invite him into your process Inviting a figure as opinionated as Mr Brecht into your rehearsal room is always challenging He and I had our share of disagreements the staging of some songs or the direction in which I guided a performance or two Nonetheless having spent a great deal of preproduction with Brecht's notes I was hyper aware of any decisions that contradicted his theories and never made them lightly It was important for me to try and discover a *Verfremdungseffekt* for 21st century America I arduously labored over each decision looking for the choice that would most illuminate the spirit of Brecht if not always his dogma My collaboration with Bertolt Brecht was an invaluable one as it revealed to me the limitless

Bertolt Brecht's epic theatre sought to change how spectators watched performances equipping them to critique and intervene in the world outside the theatre Taking its cue from his call for theatre to develop the art of spectatorship this major new study explores vision observation and spectatorship in twelve of his plays spanning his career It relates this analysis to Brecht's own formative experiences of spectatorship to his poems and theories and to productions directed by Brecht and his close collaborators Finally it investigates Brecht's attempts to transform the composition of the audience and cultivate critical spectatorship at the Berliner Ensemble the theatre he founded with his wife the actor Helene Weigel in East Berlin after the Second World War Brecht's plays foreground scenarios in which watching matters as characters witness acts of injustice watch trials or punishments engage in surveillance or observe scientific experiments These instances of onstage spectatorship play a key role in Brecht's drive to transform the viewing practices of the theatre audience showing the audience what characters

notice what they overlook and how they use or ignore the knowledge that they have gained through spectatorship Drawing on archival material and sources that have previously been rarely consulted Laura Bradley shows how Brecht and his close collaborators Erich Engel Benno Besson Peter Palitzsch and Manfred Wekwerth dealt with onstage spectatorship in performance presenting characters as observers and spectators from whom the theatre audience should learn By combining analysis of text performance and reception Brecht and the Art of Spectatorship provides rich insights into Brecht's plays rehearsal methods and stagings and the experiences of spectators at productions of his plays in the Weimar Republic in exile and in the GDR
