descended population is larger than the population of most African countries Therefore it is no surprise that Slavery Studies are one of the most consolidated fields in Brazilian historiography In the last decades a number of discussions have flourished on issues such as slave agency slavery and law slavery and capitalism slave families demography of slavery transatlantic slave trade abolition etc In addition to these more consolidated fields current research has focused on illegal enslavement global perspectives on slavery and the slave trade slavery and gender the engagement of different social groups in the abolitionist movement or Atlantic connections Taking into consideration these new trends of Brazilian slavery studies this volume of collected articles gives leading scholars the chance to present their research to a broader academic community Thus the interested reader get to know in more detail these current trends in Brazilian historiography on slavery

Blacksmiths of Ilamba Crislayne Alfagali, 2023-05-08 This study analyzes the establishment of an iron foundry in the interior 18th century of Angola It was a fruit of the Portuguese Enlightenment which encouraged investment in manufacturing particularly of iron a metal indispensable for military and technological purposes However the plans faced the resistance of African blacksmiths and founders who refused to learn foreign techniques and work processes By emphasizing Central African agency the book highlights the successful strategies of historical actors who scholars have largely ignored Based upon a wide variety of sources from Brazilian Portuguese and Angolan archives the book reconstructs how Africans were taken to work at the foundry and the important role they played in developing the form of production employed there By emphasizing continuities with African technology and the quality of the iron produced it counters interpretations of the project as an example of the failure of the Portuguese Enlightenment The analysis demonstrates the circulation of knowledge about iron production thus revitalizing debates that have posited knowledge transmission as unidirectional It also highlights the relationship between local political leaders and the colonial government in addition to elucidating the processes by which workers were organized

Surviving the Middle Passage Pieter C. Muysken, Norval Smith, 2014-12-12 This book is about the close historical and linguistic relationship between the languages of Surinam and Benin a relationship which can be viewed in terms of a Trans Atlantic Sprachbund or linguistic area It consists of a detailed analysis of various possible substrate and

adstrate effects in a number of components of the grammar in the Surinam Creole languages primarily from the Gbe languages of Benin but also from Kikongo

Bantu Clement M. Doke, 2017-09-20 Originally published in 1945 this volume represented the first to classify Bantu languages This volume does not record all the dialects but makes reference to those in which some grammatical study has been done and classifies them according to mainly geographical zones Owing to tribal migrations individual members of a particular zone may be living among members of a different zone as has been the case with the Ngoni South Eastern Zone who are found among the Eastern Bantu but the zone label is taken from the habitat of the majority

particularly on the verb and verb phrase in a variety of Niger Congo languages discussing several aspects of the verb morphology The specific languages discussed include Kinande Kilega Kinyarwanda Larry Hyman Kikongo Kituba M Ngalasso Duala E Bilao Yoruba S A Lawal Ewe A S Allen and Gbaya Bodoë P Roulon Doko The papers in Part II Semantics discuss foundational questions regarding the proper common noun distinction in two geographically very distant African languages Gborbo Krahn Janet Bing in the west and Luo Ben G Blount in the east which follow yet very similar principles And despite differences in the titles the papers on Kivunjo Lioba Moshi and Emai Schaefer and Egbokhare address the question of the semantic basis for assigning property concepts to different lexical categories There are two papers in Part III Phonology which are mostly on the prosodic features of Chiyao Al Mtenje and Manding J Tourville In Part IV Language Contact Eyamba Bokamba s and C Meyers Scotton s papers discuss speech variation and mostly formal constraints associated with them while Helma Pasch compares segmental features of Sango and Yakoma in the Central African Republic to determine whether the former is a creole Edmun Richmond focuses on the choice of national official language in sub Saharan Africa Except for Pasch all of them cover several languages and geographical areas *Kongo: Power and Majesty* Alisa LaGamma, 2015-09-16
