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Changes in Attitudes to Immigrants in Britain, 1921-2021 Ben Braber, 2025-03-04 This book reviews changes in attitudes towards immigrants in Britain and the language that was used to put these feelings into words between 1921 and 2021. It analyses in what context attitudes were articulated and where they came from. To determine what was specifically British, it makes international comparisons. It applies a historical and linguistic method for an analysis of so far relatively unused primary sources. It also explores secondary resources and to provide context engages with the existing literature that deals with immigration but is not focused on attitudes or not always covers the entire period after 1921 and links post 1921 developments to what was set in motion before 1921 to sketch a long history that runs into the present. The linguistic historical approach applied in this book brings it all together for the first time. Migration and Divided Societies Chris Gilligan, Susan Ball, 2016-04-08 The study of divided societies has focused historically on either ethnic divides in colonial or post colonial societies or on developed Western democracies which have ethnic power sharing Government structures. The study of divided societies emerged historically at a moment when there was a growing interest in the study of immigration and inter ethnic relations in developed industrial nations. These two sets of literature on divided societies and on immigration and inter ethnic relations have developed largely in isolation from each other. Both sets of literature have also tended to focus on inter ethnic relations and have paid much less attention to migration. This edited collection sets out to fill this gap in the literature through examining migration and ethnic division. The case studies examined include developed industrial nations Canada and Norway a post colonial country Kenya and three cases which feature regularly in the divided societies literature Bosnia Northern Ireland and Israel.
