

The key parameter for these illusory changes in limb position is the difference in discharge rates between afferents in the flexor and extensor muscles at a joint The final position of the phantom limb depends on its initial position suggesting that a body image uses incoming proprioceptive information for determination of starting points and endpoints when generating movements In addition the change in position does not involve limb postures that are anatomically impossible suggesting that illusory posture is constrained by body maps These results provide new information about how the brain generates phantom limbs
