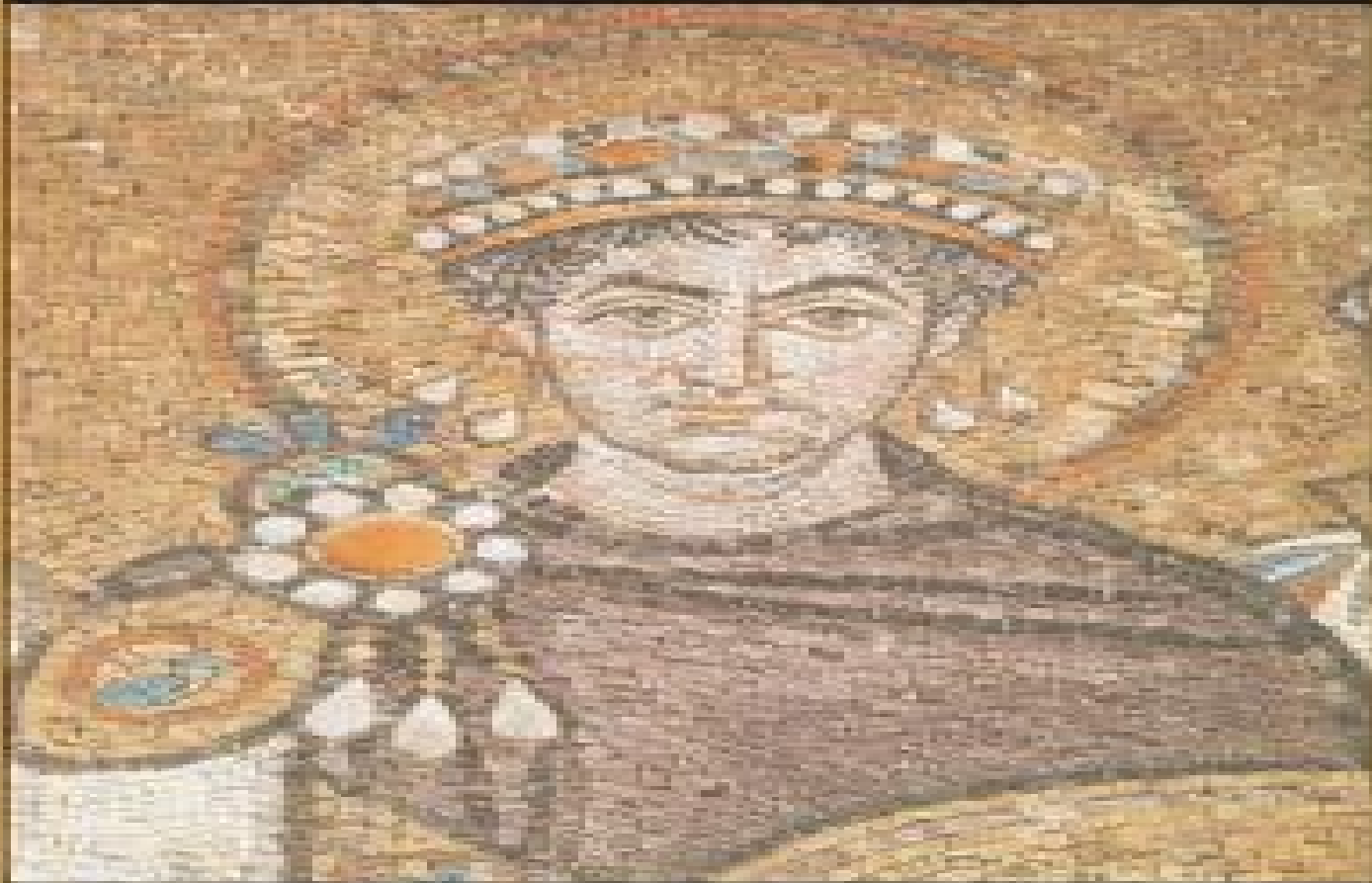

Expectations of Justice in the Age of Augustine Kevin Uhalde, 2013-03-26 Augustine bishop of Hippo between 395 and 430 and his fellow bishops lived and worked through massive shifts in politics society and religion Christian bishops were frequently asked to serve as intellectuals legislators judges and pastors roles and responsibilities that often conflicted with one another and made it difficult for bishops to be effective leaders Expectations of Justice in the Age of Augustine examines these roles and the ways bishops struggled to fulfill or failed to fulfill them as well as the philosophical conclusions they drew from their experience in everyday affairs such as oath swearing and in the administration of penance Augustine and his near contemporaries were no more or less successful at handling the administration of justice than other late antique or early medieval officials When bishops served in judicial capacities they experienced firsthand the complex inner workings of legal procedures and social conflicts as well as the fallibility of human communities Bishops represented divine justice while simultaneously engaging in and even presiding over the sorts of activities that animated society business deals litigations gossip and violence but also made justice hard to come by Kevin Uhalde argues that serving as judges even informally compelled bishops to question whether anyone could be guaranteed justice on earth even from the leaders of the Christian church As a result their ideals of divine justice fundamentally changed in order to accommodate the unpleasant reality of worldly justice and its failings This philosophical shift resonated in Christian thought and life for centuries afterward and directly affected religious life from the performance of penance to the way people conceived of the Final Judgment

International Congress of Byzantine Studies was display This is explored under eight headings which highlight different aspects of the theme and different disciplines within Byzantine Studies Empire Works and Days Infrastructures Words Texts Orthodoxy Byzantium as Display and The Future of the Past In the process many of the possible responses to Byzantium are examined the most direct response being to ask whether there was a real Byzantium or only an imaginary modern construct But the aim is to make this simple dichotomy more complex and assess first what strategies the people of Byzantium used to express their thoughts ideals fears and beliefs and then how these have been interpreted through various modern discourses The first volume presents the texts of the 28 plenary papers delivered at the Congress the second and third contain the abstracts of the approximately 700 papers written for the 64 separate panels and the sessions of communications *Coptic Legal Documents* Leslie S. MacCoull, 2009 This volume makes available for the first time fifty Coptic legal documents on a range of subjects from the sixth to eighth centuries with an introduction that places them in historical context The volume contains annotated English translations of fifty selected legal documents originally written in the Coptic language dating from the mid sixth to the mid eighth centuries They include land transfers sales wills property divisions and intergenerational disputes The choice of which language to use in recording their transactions was meaningful for the documents framers The introduction sets the texts in their historical contexts of the changing society of Egypt first under Byzantine rule then under Islamic rule Since the originals are in a language not known to most classicists and medievalists making the documents available in English should enable them to be read studied and appreciated by a wider audience

Green, 2006-11-23 Latin Epics of the New Testament is about the growth of Christianity and in particular the challenge of engaging with the Roman intellectual elite and its highly sophisticated Graeco Roman tradition In this culture epics like those of Vergil and Lucan were highly valued for their language their heroic themes and their Rome centred ideologies Roger Green examines each of these epics in detail

showing how the three authors Juvenius Sedulius and Arator repackage the New Testament as epic and try to make a bridge between two very different cultures He explores the fascinating questions of how these authors exploit epic themes such as gods heroes war and fate without playing down the very real theological concerns of their times All these poets were popular in the Middle Ages and later and are the pioneers of poetry that leads to Renaissance epic and the famous poems of John Milton

Female founders in Byzantium and beyond Lioba Theis, Margaret Mullett, Michael Grünbart, 2014 This volume presents the results of a scholarly meeting which focused on the patronage of women in the Byzantine Empire In their scope the articles address broadly not only the founding or re founding of churches and monasteries but also their rich decoration as well as numerous smaller donations In spite of increased attention to gender research in recent years a comparative treatment of the legal and economic potential that women in Byzantium could exercise in order to exert independent influence has been lacking thus a gender specific viewpoint for the volume was intentionally chosen

Bride of Blood, Bride of Light Susan Ashbrook Harvey, 2009 This study seeks to address the common bridal imagery pervasive in ancient Syriac Christianity by asking how Jacob of Serug employed the presentation of biblical women in his homilies to serve as imagery for the Church
