What is a deep approach to reading?

- Not tacitly accepting what is encountered or seeing information as separate unrelated items.
- Being analytical & analysing to synthesise and construct new meanings & connections

Action Research – dramatic results

Explicit teaching of reading strategies led to students being able to:

- Contextualise information more successfully.
- Locate and assess text evidence more effectively.
- Evaluate policy implications implied in texts more effectively.
- Suggest alternative solutions to those offered in the texts read.

Reading Strategies – students should:

- Analyse context to find background information
- Identify key arguments
- Investigate key concepts
- Evaluate claims made
- Make connections with other texts



Reading academic texts in a deep and meaningful way is something that can be developed and done in a student-centered and engaging way. Assuming, however, that students will automatically read in this way, would be a false premise.

Taught Reading Strategies & Activities:

- **Amazing Race:** A competitive activity using groupwork and focused tasks.
- **The Apprentice:** A reading task resulting in a class judged presentation.
- **Double-Entry Journals:** Student react to texts and record their responses.
- **Concept Mapping:** Graphs showing text ideas linked to personal experiences.
- **Reading Journals:** Students record their questions, comments, etc. to texts.

An explicit approach to teaching reading strategies, which when aligned to the students' own discipline, can result in a deeper approach to reading.
