

Uncovering the Language of Political Discourse in the Philippines: An NLP Study of Stylistic Features and Audience Perception

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Abstract:

This study investigated the language of political discourse in the Philippines through a Natural Language Processing (NLP) analysis of stylistic features and audience perception. A corpus of political speeches was analyzed using NLP techniques such as sentiment analysis, vocabulary analysis, and figurative language analysis. The results showed that political speeches in the Philippines exhibit distinct stylistic features, such as the use of emotionally charged words and rhetorical devices. Additionally, audience perception of the speeches varied based on the sentiment analysis, with some speeches eliciting positive responses while others were perceived negatively. Overall, this study contributes to the understanding of political discourse and stylistics in the Philippines, and demonstrates the potential applications of NLP techniques in this field.

I. Introduction

Political speeches are an important mode of communication that can shape public opinion, influence policy decisions, and affect the outcomes of elections (Hoggan & Aloni, 2020). In the Philippines, political speeches have played a critical role in the country's history, from the nationalist speeches of Jose Rizal to the fiery oratory of political leaders like Ferdinand Marcos and Cory Aquino (Santos, 2021).

In recent years, natural language processing (NLP) techniques have emerged as powerful tools for analyzing the stylistic features of political speeches and assessing audience perceptions of them (Alvarez-Melis & Jaakkola, 2020). These techniques can help researchers to identify
