enslavement in Nebraska Territory and the escape of these two enslaved Black women from Nebraska City Poised on the frontier the Graysons escape demonstrated that unique opportunities beckoned at the confluence of Nebraska Missouri Iowa and Kansas and their actions challenged slavery's tentative expansion into the West and its eventual demise in an era of territorial fluidity Their escape and the violence that followed prompted considerable debate across the country and led to the Nebraska legislature's move to prohibit slavery Drawing on multiple collections records and slave narratives Journey to Freedom sheds light on the Graysons' courage and agency as they became high profile figures in the national debate between proslavery and antislavery factions in the antebellum period

Broyld, 2022-05-25 Winner of the OHS Fred Landon Award In the early nineteenth century Rochester New York and St Catharines Canada West were the last stops on the Niagara branch of the Underground Railroad Both cities handled substantial fugitive slave traffic and were logical destinations for the settlement of runaways because of their progressive stance on social issues including abolition of slavery women s rights and temperance Moreover these urban centers were home to sizable free Black communities as well as an array of individuals engaged in the abolitionist movement such as Frederick Douglass Harriet Tubman Anthony Burns and Hiram Wilson dann j Broyld s *Borderland Blacks* explores the status and struggles of transient Blacks within this dynamic zone where the cultures and interests of the United States Canada Great Britain and the African Diaspora overlapped Blacks in the two cities shared newspapers annual celebrations religious organizations and kinship and friendship ties Too often historians have focused on the one way flow of fugitives on the Underground Railroad from America to Canada when in fact the situation on the ground was far more fluid involving two way movement and social collaborations Black residents possessed transnational identities and strategically positioned themselves near the American Canadian border where immigration and interaction occurred *Borderland Blacks* reveals that physical separation via formalized national barriers did not sever concepts of psychological memory or restrict social ties Broyld investigates how the times and terms of emancipation affected Blacks on each side of the border including their use of political agency to pit the United States and British Canada against one another for the best possible outcomes

Finley, 2024-10-03 Keith M Finley s *From Slavery to Segregation* explores the key features shaping southern politics during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries as explained in the South s defense of its racial systems It treats slavery and segregation as part of the same whole rather than as discrete institutions rooted in different periods In the process the book uncovers the deep historical origins of the region s states rights philosophy and the unfortunate persistence of a culture dominated by calls for white supremacy While highlighting the broad overview of southern racial and political thought Finley underscores the larger American struggle with racial injustice which although most pronounced in the South afflicted the entire nation The South s defense of chattel slavery became a natural model for the region s defense of segregation during the Jim Crow era Through a comparative analysis of the rhetoric employed in the justification of both racial institutions Finley reveals elements of continuity and change in the region s identity Ultimately he shows how the history of the twentieth century South is irreparably linked to the century before it For instance one cannot understand the ferocity of resistance to the Supreme Court s 1954 *Brown v Board* decision without being aware of how and why the South emerged as it did after the Civil War The Old South and the New South shared a similar constellation of ideas that informed arguments advancing their respective race based social orders which took the form of a commonality of perception regarding race a sense of being assailed by outsiders and a series of appeals to the highest secular authority in the pantheon of regional and American beliefs the Constitution Discontinuity however marked the long term strategies of both the prewar and postwar South Although segregationists sought to preserve the racial status quo as did their forebears they ultimately relented when confronted with federal power and grudgingly shifted toward a narrative that less often foregrounded race when championing states rights

Escape to the City Viola Franziska Müller, 2022-09-07 Viola Franziska M ller examines runaways who camouflaged themselves among the free Black populations in Baltimore Charleston New Orleans and Richmond In the urban South they found shelter work and other survival networks that enabled them to live in slaveholding territory shielded and supported by their host communities in an act of collective resistance to slavery While all fugitives risked their lives to escape slavery those who fled to southern cities were perhaps the most vulnerable of all Not dissimilar to modern day refugees and illegal migrants runaway slaves that sought refuge in the urban South were antebellum America s undocumented people forging lives free from bondage but without the legal status of freedpeople Spanning from the 1810s to the start of the Civil War M ller reveals how urbanization work opportunities and the interconnectedness of free and enslaved Black people in each city determined how successfully runaways could remain invisible to authorities

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
