creation of other sets of binaries and thereby dissolve the purpose and productiveness of both strangeness and liminality The intention of Monstrous Liminality is to trace the liminal sphere located between the secular and sacred that has characterized modernity itself This space has consequently altered the makeup of the stranger from something external into a figure far more liminal which is forced to traverse this uncanny space in an attempt to find new meanings for an age that is struggling to maintain any
