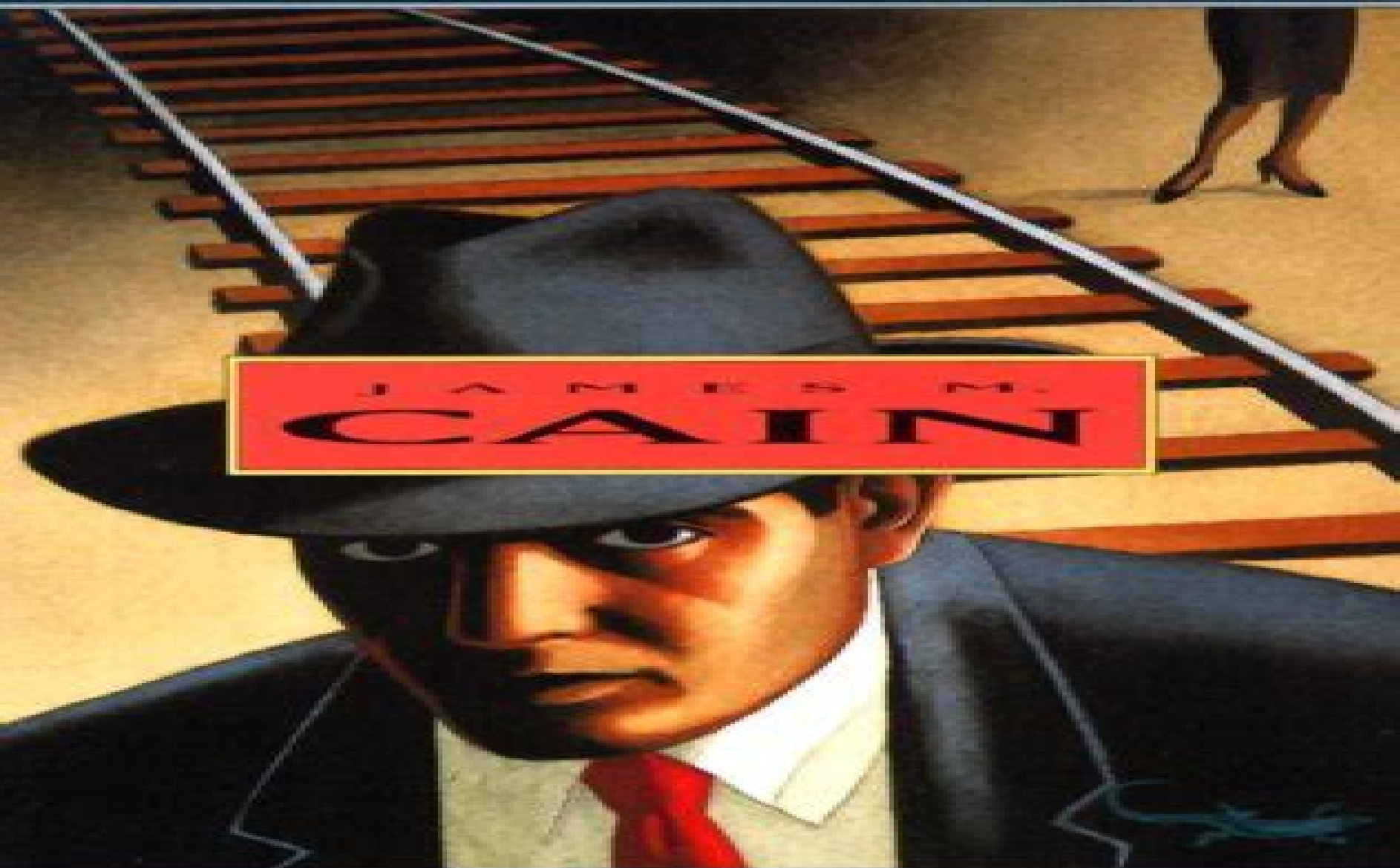

published in 1935 and affirmed James M Cain's status as a novelist. By reading it one can learn why but that is not the only observation that can be made. It is noticeable that Phyllis the Femme Fatale of the story constantly oversteps the boundaries of her gender thus posing a threat to men. The question that started this Term Paper was: How much of a threat to patriarchal masculinity is Phyllis and is this threat contained? The thesis is that Phyllis subverts patriarchal masculinity in two spheres: the business sphere and the domestic sphere and by doing this threatens it. The goal is to look at several instances where she does it and deduct if the threat she poses is contained or not. In order to prove this thesis a very short overview of the concept of sex and gender will be given which is a basic concept in cultural studies and needed when moving on to discuss masculinity during the 1930s. This will be followed by a look at the term hard-boiled fiction as it was perceived back then and the main character and the femme fatale of said genre. The literary analysis consists of a look at the world itself by using Huff's casino metaphor, a closer look at Phyllis's and Mr. Nirdlinger's relationship concluded with Phyllis's motivation. Creatures of Darkness Gene D. Phillips, 2021-03-17 An exhaustively researched survey of Raymond Chandler's thorny relationship with Hollywood during the classic period of film noir. Alain Silver, film producer and author, Raymond Chandler's seven novels including *The Big Sleep* (1939) and *The Long Goodbye* (1953) with their pessimism and grim realism had a direct influence on the emergence of film noir. Chandler worked to give his crime novels the flavor of his adopted city, Los Angeles, which was still something of a frontier town rife with corruption and lawlessness. In addition to novels, Chandler wrote short stories and penned the screenplays for several films including *Double Indemnity* (1944) and *Strangers on a Train* (1951). His work with Billy Wilder and Alfred Hitchcock on these projects was fraught with the difficulties of collaboration between established directors and an author who disliked having to edit his writing on demand. *Creatures of Darkness* is the first major biocritical study of Chandler in twenty years. Gene Phillips explores Chandler's unpublished script for *Lady in the Lake*, examines the process of adaptation of the novel *Strangers on a Train*, discusses the merits of the unproduced screenplay for *Playback* and compares Howard Hawks's director's cut of *The Big Sleep* with the version shown in theaters. Through interviews he conducted with Wilder, Hitchcock, Hawks and Edward Dmytryk over the past several decades, Phillips provides deeper insight into Chandler's sometimes difficult personality. Chandler's wisecracking private eye Philip Marlowe has spawned a thousand imitations. *Creatures of Darkness* lucidly explains the author's dramatic impact on both the literary and cinematic worlds, demonstrating the immeasurable debt that both detective fiction and the neo-noir films of today owe to Chandler's stark vision.
