

# THE GREAT PARTITION

YASMIN KHAN

Yasmin Khan's "The Great Partition" came out in 2007 to critical acclaim. A book written by a female British historian of Pakistani origin that claimed to explain 'the making of India and Pakistan' looked poised to decipher aspects of Partition not given their due by preceding historians. Indeed, it won rave reviews from senior historians such as Rothermund and Talbot as well as Von Tunzelmann and was continuously cited in subsequent books on partition, becoming quite a favorite among Indian authors.

So it was with great expectation that I began reading this book. However, near the start, at page 18 (in the 2013 revised edition) the date of formation of Muslim League was incorrectly mentioned as 1909 (it was 1906). Rather bemused I kept reading and found out that Khan had a preference for anecdotes focusing on lives of ordinary people affected by Partition. This is of course, important, but only if the political context is explained alongside it. The first such encounter was on the very next page where Khan declared that partition was not reconciled properly in the minds of people, hinting at lack of support from popular quarters. Missing here were any references to elections and how on a popular scale they were contested in India. Still, not losing hope, I ploughed on.

A number of obfuscations caught my eye. Tablighi Jamaat was, and still is, decidedly a political. Its mention alongside Jamat – i – Islami was quite odd. Nor was Arya Samaj at its zenith only in '3 decades before Partition'; rather it gained (and retained) its power throughout the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Separate electorates, the favorite topic of most Indian authors, was not something that gave 'stronger voices' to religious groups. It was in fact the religious groups who were responsible for these in the first place. The partition of Bengal, not mentioned by Khan, religiously radicalized the Hindus in Bengal, leaving little or no space for Muslims in the political sphere as they supported the partition (see Chaudhuri 1951; Qureshi 1969; Aziz, 1967; Saeed, 2000). The preceding 1893 Bombay Riots were also the work of religious groups.

Khan then says that religious differences existed, but were exacerbated by empire. This is true, though one may argue that that it would be erroneous to blame the empire solely for this. They were for example, not responsible for the designation of Muslims as 'melecchas' or unclean by Hindus. Khan mentions the separate Hindu and Muslim water but doesn't say that these existed due to Hindu demands of 'their' water to be kept 'pure' from Muslims. (See Qureshi 1969 for more details).

A constant theme in the book is that nationalist Indians were separate from apolitical Indians. That they did not affect one another. The apolitical Indians understood neither 'swaraj' (self-rule), nor Pakistan nor freedom. A bold claim to suggest that a people subjugated by colonial rule did not know about freedom, nevertheless Khan includes a number of anecdotes to back it. However, as Bayly (1996) and Powell (1993) suggest, India was a very well-informed society even when its literacy rate was non-existent. A culture of news (and later newspapers) being read out aloud in villages meant that word spread fast in India. Of course, in a country of millions of people one is bound to find someone uninformed, whose anecdote can be included to form a thesis.
