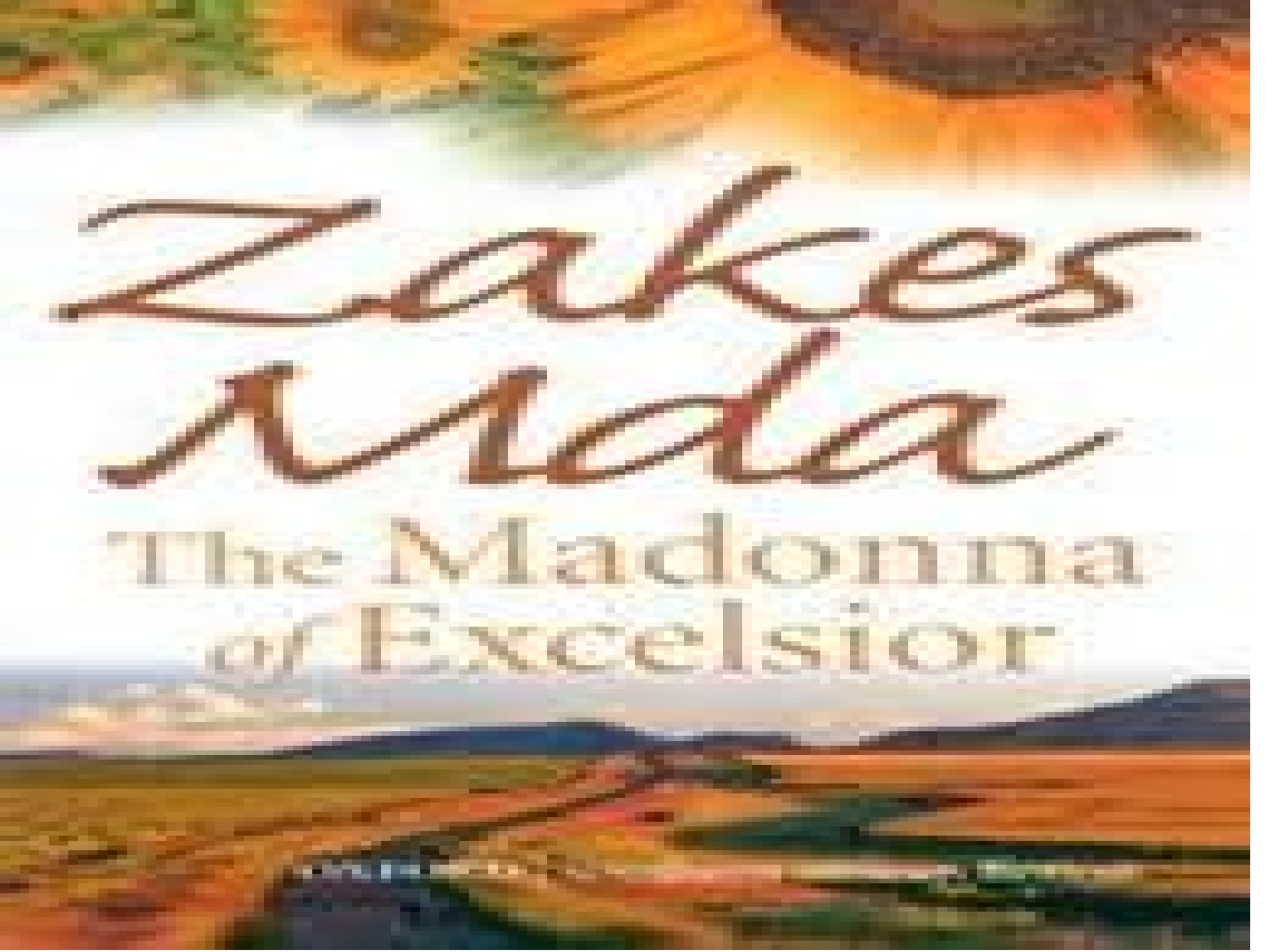

The Madonna of Excelsior Zakes Mda, 2007-05-15 A new novel by a towering presence in contemporary South African literature In 1971 nineteen citizens of Excelsior in South Africa's white ruled Free State were charged with breaking apartheid's Immorality Act which forbade sex between blacks and whites Taking this case as raw material for his alchemic imagination Zakes Mda tells the story of a family at the heart of the scandal and of a country in which apartheid concealed interracial liaisons of every kind Niki the fallen madonna transgresses boundaries for the sake of love her choices have repercussions in the lives of her black son and mixed race daughter who come of age in post apartheid South Africa where freedom prompts them to reexamine their country's troubled history at first hand By turns earthy witty and tragic *The Madonna of Excelsior* is a brilliant depiction of life in South Africa and of the dramatic changes between the 1970s and the present

The Madonna of Excelsior Zakes Mda, 2002 In 1971 nineteen citizens of Excelsior a farming community in South Africa's rural Free States were charged with breaking apartheid's Immorality Act which forbade sexual relations between blacks and whites on the pretext of avoiding miscegenation The women were jailed as they awaited trial and their white counterparts were released on bail In the end the state withdrew the charges but the accused women's lives already complicated became harder than ever Mda tells the story of a family at the heart of the scandal revealing a country in which apartheid even as it sought to keep the races apart concealed interracial liaisons of every kind Niki the fallen Madonna transgresses boundaries for the sake of love her choices have profound repercussions in the lives of her black son Viliki and her mixed race daughter Popi who come of age in the years after the end of apartheid when freedom allows them indeed compels them to figure out their racial identities for themselves As the story advances to the present the mixed society of Excelsior comes to suggest South Africa today a society far more complex and more dramatic than conventional notions of black and white will allow

Trauma, Memory, and Narrative in the Contemporary South African Novel, 2012-01-01 The contributions to this volume probe the complex relationship of trauma memory and narrative By looking at the South African situation through the lens of trauma they make clear how the psychic deformations and injuries left behind by racism and colonialism cannot be mended by material reparation or by simply reversing economic and political power structures Western trauma theories as developed by scholars such as Caruth van der Kolk Herman and others are insufficient for analysing the more complex situation in a postcolony such as South Africa This is because Western trauma concepts focus on the individual traumatized by a single identifiable event that causes PTSD Post Traumatic Stress Disorder What we need is an understanding of trauma that sees it not only as a result of an identifiable event but also as the consequence of an historical condition in the case of South Africa that of colonialism and more specifically of apartheid For most black and coloured South Africans the structural violence of apartheid s laws were the existential condition under which they had to exist The living conditions in the townships pass laws relocation and racial segregation affected great parts of the South African population and were responsible for the collective traumatization of several generations This trauma however is not an unclaimed and unclaimable experience Postcolonial thinkers who have been reflecting on the experience of violence and trauma in a colonial context writing from within a Fanonian tradition have on the contrary believed in the importance of reclaiming the past and of transcending mechanisms of victimization and resentment so typical of traumatized consciousnesses Narration and the novel have a decisive role to play here

Race, Decolonization, and Global Citizenship in South Africa Chielozona Eze, 2018 Examines the importance of South Africa s peaceful transition to democracy especially in light of Nelson Mandela s belief that cosmopolitan dreams are not only desirable but a binding duty

Black Cultural Life in South Africa Lily Saint, 2018-09-01 Under apartheid black South Africans experienced severe material and social disadvantages occasioned by the government s policies and they had limited time for entertainment Still they closely engaged with an array of textual and visual cultures in ways that shaped their responses to this period of ethical crisis Marshaling forms of historical evidence that include passbooks memoirs American B movies literary and genre fiction magazines and photocomics Black Cultural Life in South Africa considers the
