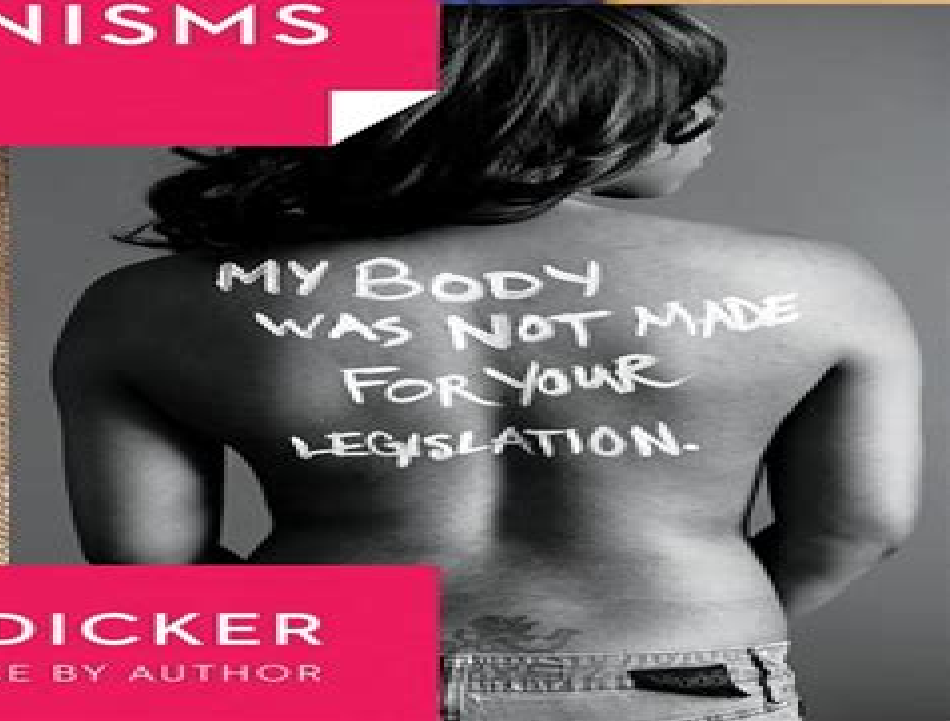

dilemma of working to reunite these movements or choosing between them some progressive women chose to lead such New Left organizations as the Jeannette Rankin Brigade while others became leaders of liberal second wave feminist movements Whether they committed to affiliating with groups that emphasized one issue over others or attempted to found groups with broad popular front type agendas Progressive women brought to their later work an understanding of how race class and gender intersect in women s organizing These women s stories demonstrate that the ultimate result of Cold War era McCarthyism was not the defeat of women s activism but rather its reconfiguration
