Distributed architectures have the potential to meet this challenge. The advantages of distributed computer control systems include the possibility of composing large systems out of pre tested components with small integration effort, their well defined fault containment properties and their capacity to make effective use of mass produced silicon chips. The IFAC Workshop series on Distributed Computer Control Systems DCCS highlights and traces the growth of key concepts in this field at their various stages of development.
