Matheson authored more than ninety short stories and dozens of novels, many of which including *I Am Legend*, *A Stir of Echoes*, *What Dreams May Come*, *The Shrinking Man*, *Hell House*, and *Bid Time Return* have been adapted into feature films. Despite his extensive body of work and influence, however, Matheson has remained largely outside the scope of academic scrutiny.
