

SECONDARY RESEASRCH

Secondary research is the analysis, summary or synthesis of already existing published research.

DEFINITION

Instead of collecting original data, as in primary research, secondary research involves data or the results of data analyses already collected. It is published in books, handbooks, textbooks, articles, encyclopedias, websites, magazines, literature reviews and meta-analyses. These are usually referred to as secondary sources.

EXAMPLES

- **Literature review:** summarizes, reviews, and critiques the existing published literature on a topic.
- **Meta-analyses:** involve the quantitative synthesis of data from multiple studies to identify trends and derive estimates of overall effect sizes.
