The Oxford Handbook of the Zambian Economy ,2024-08-23 This handbook offers a comprehensive and authoritative account of the Zambian economy including past and current trends The Zambian economy has evolved from simple and fragmented agrarian activities at the turn of the 20th Century into a wide range of organized and regulated modern economic activities today While the economy has largely revolved around the mining industry since the early 1920s when the extraction of copper and other mineral ores on the Copperbelt begun there has been a gradual broadening of economic activities over time with services now accounting for almost two thirds of gross domestic product GDP This book shows that since colonial times one of the persistent items on the economic development agenda in what is today known as Zambia has been the need to diversify the economy to reduce dependence on mining in terms of foreign exchange earnings and public revenue While the need to diversify the economy has been well acknowledged by successive Zambia governments including the current government achieving this goal has proved to be elusive so far By presenting a collection of well researched and empirically supported chapters on the key areas of the Zambian economy this volume gives readers a good sense of where the Zambian economy has come from where it is at the moment but also highlights the challenges and prospects for economic growth

Small flame but no fire Amugune, I., Cerutti, P.O., Baral, H., Leonard, S., Martius, C., 2017-11-15 Woodfuel is extremely important for energy security in Africa About eighty percent of both rural and urban populations in the 49 countries that comprise South Saharan SSA Africa rely on wood based biomass to satisfy their energy needs especially for cooking Under the Paris Agreement for Climate Change countries have submitted their Intended Nationally Determined Contributions INDCs to the Secretariat of the United Nations Convention for Climate Change UNFCCC to define their national ambitions After Paris these have now become legally binding NDCs Therefore the role that woodfuel plays in the NDCs of SSA countries needs to be assessed We reviewed and assessed INDC NDCs of a selection of SSA countries to identify how they focus on wood fuel This paper provides a first analysis of the role that woodfuels play in the NDCs Only five of the 22 countries analyzed do not mention wood fuels at all While all of those that do mention roadmaps only just over half of them offer budgetary considerations and about half of them identify institutional responsibilities for the woodfuel sector In many NDCs woodfuel is seen as a backwater technology and not the renewable energy source it could be come if sustainably harvested and managed We find that overall next iterations of the NDCs in SSA countries need to become more specific regarding the role of woodfuels in national climate and development policies

African Dept., 2017-10-25 This 2017 Article IV Consultation highlights the improved near term outlook for the Zambian economy in recent months driven by good rains and the rising world copper price The economy was in near crisis conditions from the fourth quarter of 2015 through most of 2016 reflecting the impact of exogenous shocks and lax fiscal policy in the lead up to general elections The medium term outlook for the economy is contingent on policies Achieving sustained high and inclusive growth requires a stable macroeconomic environment as well as policies and reforms to increase productivity enhance competitiveness strengthen human capital and support financial inclusion for small and medium scale enterprises

Efficient agricultural water use and management in paddy fields in Zambia Salman, M., Suzuki, H., Ahmad, W., Giusti, S., Ali, A., Mwale, S., Chikuta, S., Daka, A., Nawa, M., Sitali, M., Mukanga, M., Chitambi, M., Chilala Muccheelo, M., Lwatula, C.,2022-10-01 An increasing number of regions in the world are frequently facing water shortage and water demand is likely to grow in the next 20 30 years due to intensified agriculture population growth urbanization and climate change Future demand of water by all sectors will thus require as much as 25 to 40 percent of water to be re allocated from lower to higher productivity and employment oriented activities particularly in water stressed regions As such these reallocations are likely to come from agriculture due to its high share of water use In view of the projected rise in water demand in both agriculture and non agricultural sectors appropriate actions that increase water use efficiency especially in irrigation are crucial to sustainably enhance agricultural production and productivity In Zambia rice is one of the most important cereal food and is at the centre of major socioeconomic activity for a large share of rural population Paddy field system are especially water demanding as it needs continues inundation of the field during most of the growing season In Zambia there is no controlled infrastructure for paddy irrigation and nearly all of the rice is grown under paddy field system in the country rainfed lowlands The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations FAO has been active to increase the understanding of the status of water use efficiency and water productivity in Zambia through the project Efficient Agricultural Water Use and Management Enhancement in Paddy Fields funded by the Japan Ministry of Agriculture Forestry and Fisheries MAFF

Sustainable bioenergy potential in Zambia Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations ,Ministry of Energy of Zambia,2021-04-30 Zambia is richly endowed with a wide range of biomass sources including woodlands forests agricultural residues and livestock waste Biomass energy contributes supplies over 70 percent of the country s energy needs Due to the current extraction and consumption methods the use of biomass energy has been linked with detrimental environmental effects such as deforestation and forest degradation as well as climate change due to the loss of carbon sinks Inefficient utilisation of biomass contributes significantly to deforestation which is estimated at between 79 000 150 000 ha per year and negatively affects the health and income of rural households that depend on forest products for their livelihoods Sustainable bioenergy strategies and alternative bioenergy solutions need to be defined and integrated into current efforts of the country to increase stable and sustainable access to energy This report assesses the country context and defines which bioenergy options can be viable considering a number of solutions for electricity production cooking fuels and transport fuels at the provincial and district level Possible options originating from crop residues livestock residues and forest plantation harvesting residues are identified having netted out agriculture and forestry needs The assessment now needs to be followed by local verification and investment to deploy an initial set of bioenergy projects and test the findings on the ground

Operationalizing integrated landscape approaches in the tropics Reed, J.,Ros-Tonen, M.A.F.,Sunderland, T.C.H.,2020-10-29 Poverty food insecurity biodiversity and habitat loss are persistent global challenges that are further exacerbated by the impacts of climate change These challenges are particularly hard felt in the tropical landscapes of the global South where tensions between local socio economic and international environmental commitments are pervasive Due to the apparent failure of sectorial approaches to address such challenges more holistic strategies are being increasingly promoted Integrated landscape approaches are one such example essentially a governance strategy that engages multiple stakeholders to reconcile societal and environmental

objectives at the landscape scale to identify trade offs and potential synergies for more sustainable and equitable land management Integrated landscape approaches have been widely endorsed in the international and national policy arena within academia and in the discourse surrounding conservation and development funding However despite strong scientific theories and concepts the implementation and particularly evaluation and reporting of integrated landscape approaches in the tropics remains poorly developed The COLANDS initiative represents an explicit attempt to contribute towards the evidence base by operationalizing integrated landscape approaches in Ghana Zambia and Indonesia In this regard we aim to provide regular honest reporting of progress This book details the experiences of researchers engaged in these landscape scale initiatives across the first two years of implementation With dedicated chapters on current progress biodiversity methods and evaluation the book provides useful tools and resources for research and implementation Furthermore we consider the complex socio political challenges associated with landscape approaches with chapters focussed on how to effectively engaging stakeholders and understanding the national policy environment We then provide profiles of the sites in each of the three countries and describe the historical context current status and potential for more integrated landscape governance This book explores the techniques and strategies that can be deployed to improve the governance and management of land and natural resources and better reconcile conservation and development objectives in tropical landscapes undergoing rapid change
