Ans. $l = 38.3$ in.

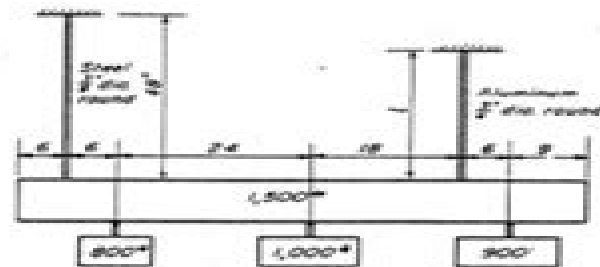
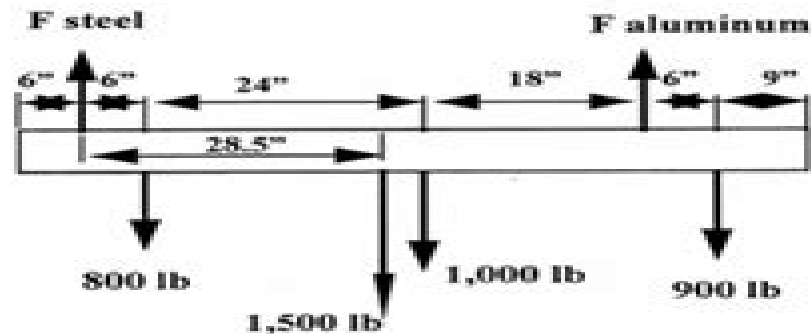


Figure 1-41 Problem 1.

Solution: To solve this problem we will need to draw a free body diagram as shown below:



The moment at the left rod:

$$48F_s = 1,500 \times 28.5 + 800 \times 6 + 1,000 \times 30 + 900 \times 54$$

$$F_s = \frac{126,150}{48} = 2,628 \text{ lbf}$$
