

complex real world example involving the near real time capturing and analysis of neurophysiological data from a neonatal intensive care unit NICU was chosen A system was engineered to gather raw data analyse that data using di erent analysis techniques uncover information incorporate that information into the system and curate the evolution of the discovered knowledge The application domain was chosen for three reasons rstly because it is complex and no comprehensive solution exists secondly it requires tight interaction with domain experts thus requiring the handling of subjective knowledge and inference and thirdly given the dearth of neurophysiologists there is a real world need to provide a solution for this domain
