Digest of Ethiopia's National Policies, Strategies and Programs Taye Assefa, 2008 Having just emerged from a prolonged civil war and faced with the urgent tasks of establishing political stability and reinvigorating an economy in tatters the Transitional Government of Ethiopia 1991-1995 had to set a new direction for the economic reconstruction and social rehabilitation of the war-torn and poverty-ridden country. During the Transitional Period a spate of new policies and strategies defining the development priorities, goals and implementation instruments of the new regime led by the EPRDF was introduced. This work is a synthesis of various sectoral policies and an attempt to trace the genesis of the policies, highlight the continuities, significant departures and other salient features. Each of the reviews in this digest briefly analyses the critical elements of the policies, identifies major gaps in the conceptualisation of the policy as well as the achievements registered and the challenges encountered in its implementation. The authors also try to identify the outstanding issues to be addressed by policymakers and suggest remedies. The policy reviews have been grouped into three parts and presented under social, economic and governance sectors.

Land to Investors Dessalegn Rahmato, 2011 Under its program of land investments the Ethiopian government has leased out huge tracts of land to domestic and foreign investors on terms that are highly favorable to both but particularly to foreign ones. Critical reports on the bonanza reaped by foreign capital have appeared in the world media and the websites of international activist organizations and while some of these are based on questionable evidence the global attention they have drawn may well be deserved given the image of the country as a land of poverty and hunger. This study which is based on information gathered from field interviews as well as other sources looks at the subject from a land rights perspective with emphasis on the relations of power between small land users and their communities on the one hand and the state on the other. At bottom what is at stake is the land and the resources on it and what is being grabbed are rights that in most cases belong to peasant farmers, pastoralists and their communities. In the long run the shift of agrarian system from small scale to large scale foreign dominated production which is what the investment program is now doing will marginalize small producers and cause immense damage to local ecosystems, wildlife habitats and biodiversity.

Village Gone Viral Marit Tolo Østebø, 2021-02-16 In 2001 Ethiopian Television aired a documentary about a small rural village called Awra Amba where women ploughed, men worked in the kitchen and so-called harmful traditional practices did not exist. The documentary radically challenged prevailing images of Ethiopia as a gender conservative and aid dependent place and Awra Amba became a symbol of gender equality and sustainable development in Ethiopia and beyond. *Village Gone Viral* uses the example of Awra Amba to consider the widespread circulation and use of modeling practices in an increasingly transnational and digital policy world. With a particular focus on traveling models, policy models that become viral through various vectors ranging from NGOs and multilateral organizations to the Internet, Marit Tolo Østebø critically examines the hidden dimensions of models and model making. While a policy model may be presented as a best practice one

that can be scaled up and successfully applied to other places the local impacts of the model paradigm are far more ambivalent potentially increasing social inequalities reinforcing social stratification and concealing injustice With this book the author ultimately calls for a reflexive critical anthropology of the production circulation and use of models as instruments for social change

Urban Planning and Everyday Urbanisation Nadine Appelhans, 2016-12-15 Urbanisation in Bahir Dar Ethiopia poses challenges to urban living conditions Despite large scale housing programmes from the side of the government construction and settling processes have largely remained incremental Nadine Appelhans focuses on the relation between statutory planning and practices of everyday urbanisation The findings from Bahir Dar suggest that some mundane regimes of building the city are patronised while others are considered undesired by policy makers Based on this insight the author argues that urban development in Bahir Dar needs to be locally grounded differentiated and inclusive to avoid further tendencies of segregation

The Politics of Inclusive Development Samuel Hickey, Kunal Sen, Badru Bukenya, 2015 It is now widely accepted that politics plays a significant role in shaping the possibilities for inclusive development However the specific ways in which this happens across different types and forms of development and in different contexts remains poorly understood This collection provides a state of the art review regarding what is currently known about the politics of inclusive development Leading academics offer systematic reviews of how politics shapes development across multiple dimensions including through growth natural resource governance poverty reduction service delivery social protection justice systems the empowerment of marginalised groups and the role of both traditional and non traditional donors The volume not only provides a comprehensive update but also a ground breaking range of new directions for thinking and acting around these issues The book's originality thus derives not only from the wide scope of its case study material but also from the new conceptual approaches it offers for thinking about the politics of inclusive development and the innovative and practical suggestions for donors policy makers and practitioners that flow from this

State and Economic Development in Africa Aaron Tesfaye, 2017-07-20 This book critically assesses the impact of Ethiopia's policy of Agriculture Development Led

Industrialization Employing qualitative and quantitative analysis it presents empirical evidence suggesting persistent economic growth The research highlights improvements in infrastructure health care education poverty alleviation as well reductions in infant mortality rate The impact of this economic growth has however had led to only slight improvements in the plight of the poor The author argues that while significant steps have been achieved with measurable economic gains there are still undeniable obstacles within the federal system prevailing patron client relationships constraints on state capacity to efficiently and effectively implement policy and bureaucratic rent seeking in the provision of public goods The author concludes that these problems will have to be resolved before Ethiopia's political economy can achieve the stage of sustainable development

Regional Development Poles and the Transformation of African Economies Benaiah Yongo-Bure, 2020-02-17 This book argues that the development of capital goods manufacturing industries in four relatively large African economies will create regional development poles from which industrialization will spread to the smaller African countries In this book Benaiah Yongo Bure explains the need for capital goods industries in Africa and shows how manufacturing can transform economies He outlines the roles of the Democratic Republic of Congo DRC Ethiopia Nigeria and South Africa as potential regional development poles showing how the existing economies natural resources and populations of these countries make them ideal candidates while also considering possible challenges to industrialization Finally the author assesses what major infrastructural development is needed to link the countries and regions to increase the spread effects of economic growth This book will be of interest to scholars and policy makers in economic development and regional development in Africa

African continent The majority of the African countries are members of overlapping and sometimes contradictory RECs For instance in East Africa while Kenya and Uganda are both members of EAC and COMESA Tanzania which is also a member of the EAC left COMESA in 2001 to join SADC In West Africa while all former French colonies belong to ECOWAS they simultaneously keep membership of UEMOA an organization which is not recognized by the African Union AU Such multiple and confusing memberships create unnecessary duplication and dims the light on what ought to be priority Various chapters in this book have therefore sought to identify and proffer solutions to related challenges confronting the workings of the RECs in different sub regions of the African continent The discourses range from security to the stock exchange identity integration development framework labour movement and cross border relations The pattern adopted in the book involves devolution of related discussions from the general to the specific that is from the continental level to sub regional case studies

Analysis of Ethiopia's Wildlife Policies and Laws Didi Wamukoya,2016-06-07 Ethiopia is committed to wildlife conservation and has in place a wildlife policy and strategy that guides the administration of the wildlife sector This policy is translated into legislation for purposes of making its provisions enforceable There is legislation that establishes the institutional framework of the wildlife sector and legislation that regulates the wildlife sector The wildlife legislation has strong provisions that address wildlife crime and wildlife trafficking but it also has gaps that need to be sealed in order to successfully administer and adjudicate over wildlife cases Ethiopia is quite strong in complying with international standards that address wildlife crime including standards on reduction of wildlife trade fighting of organized criminal groups curbing money laundering and fighting corruption The effectiveness of the legislation cannot be accurately gauged as there is lack of consistent and reliable data on wildlife cases
