treatment for adults with borderline personality disorder BPD has recently been applied to other populations Given the increase in the number of adolescent girls seeking treatment for serious and potentially life threatening behaviors an empirically validated treatment approach would be extremely helpful to the mental health community and add to the body of knowledge regarding adolescent girls with suicidal behaviors The present study compared the outcome of the addition of an adapted version of a DBT skills training group to psychotherapy with the outcome of a treatment as usual TAU control group for suicidal adolescents with borderline personality features It examined differences in suicide ideation and self injurious behavior as well as self reported levels of depression anxiety and anger before and after treatment in an outpatient program Although the participants were not randomly assigned there were no significant differences between the initial DBT group and the TAU control group on sample characteristics including age parasuicidal behavior number of features of borderline personality disorder depression anxiety and anger The study was based on a repeated measures design and yielded significantly greater reduction in suicide ideation and depression in the DBT group than the TAU group The results indicate that DBT skills training may be an effective outpatient treatment approach for adolescent girls who are at risk for suicide

injury NSSI is an intentional act of self harm without the intention of completing suicide Prevalence rates among adolescents engaging in NSSI are increasing and are higher than any age group Although current research continues to expand with regards to methodology prevalence and functions a dearth of evidence remains around the treatment of this behavior among adolescents A small but growing body of research on Dialectical Behavior Therapy for Adolescents DBT A for decreasing suicidal ideation and related behaviors exists DBT A is an adaptation of the integrated treatment of DBT and has been found

to improve one's maladaptive thoughts, behaviors, and emotional reactions but has not yet been used to address NSSI separately from suicidal ideation. The following study used a changing conditions design across participants to investigate improvements in NSSI and suicidal ideation separately after completing phases of DBT. The study revealed mixed results regarding reductions in NSSI and suicidal ideation through phases of DBT. A Total DBT treatment revealed the most promise in decreasing suicidal ideation with the most improvement during middle treatment phases. Implications of the current findings and recommendations for future research are discussed.
