It examined differences in suicide ideation and self injurious behavior as well as self reported levels of depression anxiety and anger before and after treatment in an outpatient program Although the participants were not randomly assigned there were no significant differences between the initial DBT group and the TAU control group on sample characteristics including age parasuicidal behavior number of features of borderline personality disorder depression anxiety and anger The study was based on a repeated measures design and yielded significantly greater reduction in suicide ideation and depression in the DBT group than the TAU group The results indicate that DBT skills training may be an effective outpatient treatment approach for adolescent girls who are at risk for suicide
