Archaeobacteria are simple in their organization

Found in extreme environments

Sphere, rod, plate, spiral, flat or square-shaped

Cell wall is composed of pseudo peptidoglycans

Introns are present

Exhibit neither glycolysis nor Krebs's cycle

Has three types: methanogens, halophiles and thermophiles

Asexual reproduction methods like binary fission, budding and fragmentation are used

RNA polymerase consists of a complex subunit pattern

Membrane lipids are ether-linked, branched, aliphatic chains, containing D-glycerol phosphate

Examples include *Halobacterium*, *Lokiarchaeum*, *Thermoproteus*, *Pyrobaculum*, *Thermoplasma* and *Ferroplasma*

Eubacteria are more complex than archaeobacteria

Found everywhere on earth

Cocci, bacilli, vibrio, rods, filaments or spirochetes in shape

Cell wall is composed of peptidoglycans with muramic acid

Introns are absent

Exhibit both glycolysis and Krebs's cycle

Has two types: gram positive and gram negative

Capable of producing spores in order to remain dormant during unfavorable conditions

RNA polymerase consists of a simple subunit pattern

Membrane lipids are ester-linked, straight chains of fatty acids, containing L-glycerol phosphates

Examples include *Mycobacteria*, *Bacillus*, *Sporohalobacter*, *Clostridium* and *Anaerobacter*
